REPAIRS now done, Bottom painted and planks of rudder repaired.
 Not finding the Captain or Owner of this vessel on board, I
 sent a note addressed to the Owner through the Broker
 Messrs Cotterworth, informing him that the vessel should now
 be placed under survey for (t.s.) in accordance with the
 Rules Sec. 17. The vessel has since been removed from
 the dry dock and immediately in the wet dock commenced
 loading salt. - I have not had any reply to my note. I
 have attended twice in order to see the Captain but
 could not find him. The vessel has now a considerable
 quantity of salt on board.
