## REPAIRS

Now under special Survey old rules section 18.

The whole of the ceiling lifted and both surfaces of Plating scraped and exposed to view, two plates in bottom renewed, Windlass, and one rough tree on port side renewed with English Oak. Deck repaired and Caulked, inside and outside painted with two coats of red lead. The outside plating of this Vessel appears to have suffered no perceptible diminution.
