## REPAIRS owing to damage

One Garboard plate & plate adjoining in next strake out (Starboard side Amidships) taken out & replaced, several rivets in Garboard plate opposite taken out & renewed, Main Bulwarks - both sides - repaired & part renewed, and Main Rail - 33 feet long - Port side abaft fore rigging taken out & renewed & Elm. A portion of Main deck in after Saloon renewed - of Pine, Engine room Skylight, Companion, Round House & Bridge board repaired, Steering Gear Three Boats & two pair of boats Harbors renewed & the vessel coated with Composition outside and painted inside partly.
