REPAIRS

Now done viz. The Bottom scraped, cleaned, and painted with two coats of Red lead and one of Tallow & Red lead, and the topsides with two coats of Red lead and one of Black, and inside from the turn of Bilge to the upper deck stringer with two coats of Red lead.

The timber boards fore and aft and several boards of ceiling lifted - the Floors, Keelson, Frames, Rivets, Plating &c examined and found good, & the Portland cement very firm.

The raised quarter deck caulked.
