Renewed, the after piece of Keel, Rudder-post, Rudder, Rudder-bumk,
three stern frames, three reversed angle irons to stern frames, one eye plate,
one bops plate on Larboard side, seven plates in buttock, two braces to
Rudder, and two cleats, and rudder cant, also a new propeller. -
The upper and poof decks recaulked, and the bottom coated with
Red-lead and tallow. -
