REPAIRS

now done in accordance with Rule Sec 20 for Iron Ships.

All Ceiling in flat of bottom & bilges - both sides fore & aft - removed & the vessel scraped inside & out including upper deck waterways - found the surfaces of plating, angle-irons & rivetting in good condition. Windlass & lashing wood linings taken off, & Chain Cables examined on deck.

Repairs done viz -

Ceiling in flat of bottom (made moveable by hatches) part renewed of rock elm 2 1/2 thick, spunkles of Rudder renewed, the vessel cleansed & painted throughout, & the fore & main-mast now fitted with double topsail yards.

Fore yard 54'0" + 17' (Iron) plates 5/16, 3/16, 1/4 - 3 Angle irons 3 x 3 x 5/16 double rivetted in butts
Main " 66'0" + 17' " " 5/16, 3/16, 1/4 - 3 " " 3 x 3 x 5/16 & single in laps
