REPAIRS Through damage sustained (see special Report hereon) 5 Bulwark plates new & 2 taken out straightened & riveted. A larger angle iron (5 x 3 x 5/16) introduced under Bulwark Rail on the Starboard side, all new stranchions to Iron Bulwarks are of increased diameter - secondary built straps introduced at upper edge of sheerstrakes, new main bulwark rail on the Starboard side and one new piece on the Port side. Part new Toppallant rails and bulwark built of outside plating in way of Engine Room and coal bunkers recaulted, 2 stern & Quarter frames strengthened & plates of Port Quarter taken out, reset & riveted. 5 new Boats Houses amidships under Bridge rebuilt. Bottom recoated with McJanes' composition
