Revised a few Rivets in the Bottom plating, the greater number passing through Propeller-post, also both Harrow Pipes, and the Starboard Head the latter being of American Oak. Windlass fitted with new iron wheels. Caulked flat of upper deck, and coated Bottom with Mr. Lavis's composition over White and Red lead.
