## REPAIRS

The Boilers taken out, and renewed. The Boiler spaces examined and all found good. The Asphalt there now cemented over. All the Ceiling in Fore, Main & After Holds removed and the plating scraped there and in twist decks and Bulkheads. Outside plating also scraped. The following Repairs have been done on account of plates and Ribs rusted:— 14 plates in garboard strakes, renewed  $\frac{5}{8}$  in thickness, and a large number of Ribs renewed both sides. Inside surface of plating in Fore, Main & After Holds cemented to Bilges. Plating in twist decks and outside painted. Hull caulked. Ceiling all relaid. She is now in good Condition.
