REPAIRS Now done:-

Renewed a number of slack rivets, in the Butts of Bottom Plating, in various places, - and a few others in the Steel: - also 25 feet of rivets in one edge of Bottom plating, amidships, on each side. Several Butts recaulked, and the edges re-chipped and caulked, in way of new rivets.

Worked and riveted a four feet length of Angle Iron, on three consecutive frames, which were found to have been broken, on the Port. Bilge.

Scraped and painted the Bottom with Red-lead paint, and caulked the whole of the Upper and Poop Decks.
