REPAIRS At the present time the owner requested a survey to be held.

It appears from the Log Book and information received from the Chief Officer and Carpenter that when attempting to enter this Port on the 14<sup>th</sup> Inst (with 800 tons of Iron in from Middlesbro) she got on shore and remained about nine hours, when she got off came into the South Dock, completed her cargo with coals, and a survey requested.

So far as we could examine her we could not detect any damage or injury, but considered her too deep in the water. - Please see the copy of survey attached.
