Scraped bottom and painted the same with one coat of oxide of iron, one of red lead and one of Gipsborne's paint; lifted ceiling to above bilges and cleaned and cleaned and painted floor plates, reverse iron, Keelsons &c and repaired cement; also raised cement about two feet on each side and painted inner surfaces of plating with red lead paint.

Having lost the flukes of a Trotman's anchor another has been supplied which has been proved at Lloyd's proving house London to a test of Iron
