REPAIRS Now done: - Scraped and painted the Bottom with three coats of M^r Lewis' patent Paint. -

She is one Bower Anchor and 15 fms of chain cable deficient. - Wrote to the Owners respectfully recommending the stores referred to, to be supplied, "in order that I may report her to the Committee as being eligible to retain the Figure '1' for "Stores in the Register Book". - To day I saw this ship near the dock entrance, ready for going out at high water; - made inquiries, on board, and was told, that the new chain and anchor had not arrived. -
