now done. The bottom scraped and painted, the Boiler and the coal bunkers taken out; in the boiler compartment the Asphalte chipped off where necessary, all iron work scraped and painted, several rivets renewed, and the bottom cemented; the Engine repaired and a new boiler and coal bunkers fitted; that portion of the raised quarter deck over the boilers renewed with 3 1/2 Yellow pine and the beams and tie plates refitted. Both holds painted, a strake of ceiling at the bilges lifted and the bilges cleaned out and painted; the hold stanchions refitted and a 3/8 plate fitted vertically between the End Bulkhead and the end of the Waterballast tanks, to form a connection; and that compartment cemented.
