REPAIRS

now done, the fore and main hatchways altered and a deck tie-plate ranging the whole length between them fitted  $13\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{6}$  parts of 6 strakes of deck on each side next the hatchways renewed of yellow-pine, Iron Camings to engine and Boiler space carried up to the bridge and a steering-wheel fitted over the same. All the Ceiling in the holds lifted in the glass for an examination of the plates frames, &c., and found in good condition, Cement repaired in places, Ceiling refitted, and in the fore & main holds fitted with double ceiling, deck caulked, bottom scraped and painted.
