PAIRS

The Vessel placed in a patent slip; the Limber boards, and one stake of ceiling lifted all fore and aft, with both surfaces of plating exposed. Tested Cement by beating and chipping, found to be adhering satisfactorily. Caulked a few bits of garboard stake and bottom plating, and renewed a few of the rivets in Hull.

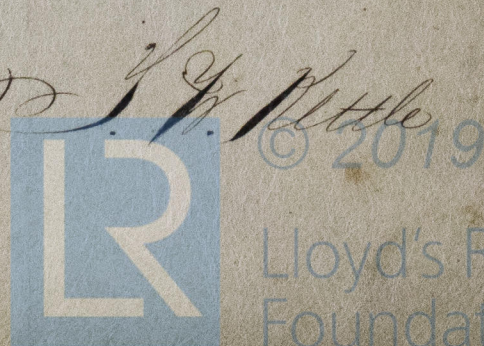
