REPAIRS

Took off planking at bilges equal to a strake on each side as well as man hole doors ^{of tanks} for the examination of the asphalt which proved in good condition, adhering firmly to frames, plating &c., also lifted part ceiling on upper side of tank for examination of plating which was found to be in a good state.
