Now done, the bottom scraped and painted with three coats (Zinc & Tallin) rigging stripped and overhauled, new fore topmast, and a bower anchor now supplied 25th 3. 20 ex stock tested to 25th 6th at Poplar Proving House assigned by J. M. Gladstone 30th Decr 65 No. 1459. She is now in good condition fit in our opinion to remain as classed A. 1.
