REPAIRS

Now done. - The Boilers have been taken out and replaced by new. The Engines taken to pieces and refitted. The Cement in the Engine Room entirely removed and new put in; in other parts of the Hold the Ceiling has been lifted from Bilge to Bilge, and an extra Coating of Cement has been introduced removing all doubtful and defective places. The Plating and Rivets where exposed were found to be in good condition. The Outside Plating scraped clean from Keel to Gunwale and recoated with three coats of Paint. Inside - all the Frames &c. including Plating, Beams and Stringers scraped and repainted.
