REPAIRS

Lifted the timber boards and ceiling, more than equal to a strake all fore and aft both sides throughout, and exposed the ribs rivets plates inside and outside, by cleaning, scraping, &c., and carefully tested the Cement and repaired it where necessary. found it generally, well adhering, and the plates, ribs, rivets as far as seen in good condition

Renewed some few of the rivets in the back of Rudder found loose or unsatisfactory, overhauled and repaired stuffing box to the head of it

Cut out two Ports on each side in the iron bulwark berthing (extra Ports) for the clearance of the seas breaking aboard.

Fore topsail yard (upper one) now repaired.
