A large portion of the Ceiling - both sides - removed, all oxidation beaten & scraped off - the surfaces of the plating &c in good condition & now coated inside with iron ore paint, & outside with Composition & other paint.

Nearly all the Ceiling in flat of bottom renewed of Spruce fir, & the Waterways & rough tree stanchions caulked.
