### REPAIRS

How done, The bottoms scraped and painted with oxide of iron and grease; the ceiling lifted from bilge keelson to bilge keelson, and the timbers cleared and floors &c examined, a strake of ceiling under the hold beams and one in the tween decks removed and the plating, frames &c found in excellent condition; a portion of the wood lining taken off the windlass and the main piece examined and found good.
