## REPAIRS

Cleaned her outside and inside. Renewed three of the rivets in the bottom. — Examined and repaired the Comings to hatchways a new fore and aft bearer fitted to one, of oak. and bearers repaired, and strengthened, the hand holes to hatches filled up and sheathed the whole of them with  $\frac{3}{4}$  deal boards nailed on athwartships. hand ring bolts fitted to each.

Dead lights or iron shutters of  $\frac{3}{16}$  plates fitted over Eng<sup>n</sup> room lights. Overhauled the caulking of butts and seams of waterway. & Eighteen water "ballast tanks" put on board, nine on each side. —

The bottom painted over with black varnish.
