REPAIRS

Now done:- Sighted the Bottom and Caulked a few Butts on each side, and renewed a number of Rivets in the Bottom, and Rudder. Rebusked the Rudder-pieces. Painted the outside with two coats of Zinc-paint - and one of Gallon. Caulked part of the main-deck and payed the whole of it with bright Varnish.

Removed the washstrakes all round, and caulked round the Roughtree-stations - Extra bolted the Waterways and fitted an Iron Stay to each Roughtree Station.
