REPAIRS

Lifted lumber hatches and ceiling at bilges equal to an entire strake, also ceiling in flat of bottom for examination of frames, floor plates, cement &c. all of which were found to be in good condition, the cement adhering in a satisfactory manner. — Scraped and painted bottom with two coats of red and white lead paint and one of tallow, also painted floor plates with red lead paint. — Extra hooped fore and main mast heads over doubling plates.
