REPAIRS now done:

The vessel placed in dry dock, the whole of the ceiling in hold lifted, the cement examined and found good, both surfaces of outside plating exposed, all oxidation removed, and the ^{vessel} repainted inside and outside, the windlafs stripped, the Chain Cables ranged on deck and found to be the same in quantity as originally supplied to the vessel, viz: 1% 240 faths. Renewed, the whole of the Ceiling in Hold with Baltic Lii, Upper deck re-caulked.
