REPAIRS now done, the greater part of 5 strakes of deck on each side renewed, deck caulking, bottom scraped and painted, and the 3 lower pintles of rudder renewed.

The renewal of the strakes of deck above referred to is in consequence of having been cut for ventilation when the Ship was employed in the Abyssinian - transport service.
