REPAIRS Now done

Sighted bottom (scraped), and painted with 2 Coats of Lead, and one of Gallum; the topsides painted. Caulked the upper deck throughout.

During the time this Vessel was in Dock a large amount of Coal was shifted in the Hold, in consequence of which, when she was being undocked, and as the Tide was lifting her, she slipped off the blocks, on to her Starboard bilge, and there rested fairly on the bottom of the Dock without any Chores (she has a flat plate keel) in this position she was examined both inside and outside, and no signs of starting could be observed either in butts, edges, or rivets; about 20 hours after, she was examined afloat, with the same results, was being fast loaded, and making no water.
