REPAIRS

The timber boards and ceiling in the flat of bottom all fore and aft on each side secured. The frames, Plating Rivets &c found in good condition. The cement coating sound and good and adhering satisfactorily to the iron.

Inside from Bilge to upper deck stringer plate scraped and painted. Bottom coated with Composition.

Fore and Main upper Spermal Yards of iron two plates in the round thick at things $\frac{1}{2}$ at Yard Arms single riveted in the lading edges, batt part double and part triple lapped throughout. More stiffeners in each of $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ iron stamped Silverdale Iron Works.
