REPAIRS

Now done - Nearly the whole of the Ceiling removed fore and aft and the inside of the keel scraped, chipped, and painted - the Cement repaired where necessary and a large quantity added - her bottom scraped, painted, and coated with Dr. Dunn's Composition - her spars scraped and painted, and she has been fitted with Cement between the Roughtree Stanchions in lieu of wood -
Her Chain Cables have been lanced, examined, and found good and sufficient - the Shackle Pins knocked out, and refitted -
The Windlass stripped, examined, and found good and sufficient -
The Masts and Yards overhauled by a Mast Maker - his Certificate is appended -
