Lifted the timbers and more than a strake of ceiling each side. Cleaned, scraped, and examined her inside and outside as far as practicable. sighted ribs, rivets, plates, and the cement. — repaired the bowsprit. Upsail, and t'gall sail from damage. — Coated the bottom with two of red lead, and one of McGinnis's Pat^r composition
