## REPAIRS.

Now done:- Removed the Lumber on both sides, fore and aft, and feeling equal to one stroke, on each side. Found the Iron Work in a good state of preservation; and the Effluent adhering firmly to the plating; the condition of which was ascertained by heating. Scraped and painted the whole of the Iron Work inside and outside.

The Main and Pile Rails have been additionally bolted together - and connected to the Main-bulwarks by means of 18 angle-iron knees on each side properly stayed.
