## REPAIRS

Main Hatchway shortened 13 ft. 4 Deck Beams extended across. Deck renewed from main to Fore Hatchway and about one half the deck each side of Hatchways part new Top gall "bulwarks. Spars all new, except the Bowsprit and Mizzen Mast. & are of Pitch Pine. Red Pine and Spruce - Rigging all new. Standing of wire, running of Hemp. Decks recaulked

2 Deck Houses now erected one aft and one forward Bottom cleaned and coated

Round House aft - 24.09
