now done on account of damage, and for survey.
A new upper piece of stem, and three plates in the Starboard, and four in the Port bow now fitted.
For survey: The hold entirely cleared and the timbers lifted; the whole of the ceiling from the hip keelsons upwards, and a great deal in bottom removed, and the vessel thoroughly scraped and painted inside and outside. The cement where found defective has now been renewed, and planks forward re-caulked.
