Sighted bottom, painted ditto, and renewed the braces to Rudder; Refitted and repacked the Bush to propeller; and repaired some of the hatches to main hatchway.

The Owners declined submitting the Vessel to the triennial Survey until the commencement of the next Year, when they intend putting in a new Boiler and would prefer doing so then.
