The Covers to the "Man holes" in the inner or tank bottom all removed, and also two strakes of Ceiling at the bilges.  
 The bilges cemented, the inside of the vessel thoroughly cleaned, and painted; and the bottom scraped, and coated with two coats of Tar and Black Lead, and one coat of Tallow and Black Lead. -
