## REPAIRS, &c.

The whole of the hatches in ceiling on each side lifted fore and aft and the hull found in good condition. Cement repaired where necessary, and the floors cleaned down and cement washed. Inside from bilges up, also outside, beaten and cleaned, and the whole painted; bottom coated with zinc paint and Runey's composition. Windlass stripped and found in good condition. Cables ranged and found complete.
