The timber boards, and ceiling equal to one stroke fore and aft on both sides removed, cement examined and found good the fore and after holds, and fore peak scraped and painted from deck to turn of bilge, the bottom outside cleaned and coated with Mc Innis' composition
 The Owners were not disposed to remove ceiling to an extent that would entitle her to the S. S. N^o 2 at this time.
