REPAIRS, &c. - The hatches lifted in ceiling fore and aft on each side. Cement repaired where necessary and floors cleaned down and cement-washed. Outside, also inside from bilges up, cleaned down and painted; bottom coated with zinc paint and a preparation of tallow.
