REPAIRS, &c.

At the present time the Boilers taken out, limbers & ceiling at the bilge taken up and the bottom examined and found good, cement renewed where wanted or worn off. New Boilers, one damaged plate shifted, new Rudder head, & a few planks in the Decks (where the Boilers came up) of Pine. Decks caulked. Painted & coated inside & out.

Engineer's certificate attached, also a letter from the Master of the Ship seeking the highest class which I beg to submit for the Committee's consideration.
