REPAIRS

Lifted the timbers and ceiling planks three or more strakes fore and aft. both sides. Overhauled Ribs, rivets, plates, inside, and outside, repaired the Cement in places. Coated the plating outside, likewise the inside, repaired and made good the Ceiling. — Renewed all deck planks found unsatisfactory. Six or seven on each side towards the fore end. Unshipped the Windlass, refitted it, made good the linings.
