Bent stem taken out heated & replaced, 4 broken shell plates taken off on the S. side & replaced with new, 3 do. on the P. side, one bent one taken off heated & resch. replaced, Foremost length of waterway on S. side forecabin renewed with G.P. after length of solid work above waterway renewed with G.P. moulding rail new, P. side. Forecastle deck caulked, keeling lifted in fore peak & part of beam, the same relaid. Vessel coated with Prime & black barnish.
