## REPAIRS, &c.

On examination of this vessel I found her in a very dirty state -

All the ceiling has now been removed, the original Cement has been repaired where necessary, and the Cement has been carried a plate higher on each bilge -

The inner surface of the outside plating, angle iron and rivets has been all properly cleaned, and found in a good state of preservation - all has been painted, and the ceiling replaced

On the outside she has also been cleaned. The surface of iron was found all right and has been again painted. Windlass stripped & Iron work repaired.
