The plating outside and in also the plank sheers and waterways scraped or cut bright, the ceilings lifted, the plating tested by drilling and found to be not perceptibly diminished in thickness. Windlass and chains examined and all other requirements of the Rules S.S. No 3 complied with -

A few defective rivets in the bottom renewed -

Application having been made for this vessel to be classed under new Rules; it will be found that her dimensions and sizes of plating frames &c. are the same as those of her sister ship the "Blonde".
