at present been docked with a view to scrape clean & recoat bottom  
 On examination I found the shell plating & rivets outside & where  
 seen inside all in good order throughout  
 Has now been scraped outside from Gunwall down to lower part  
 of Keel & thereafter Coated from Water line upwards with 2 Coats  
 bit paint viz one of Red Lead & 1 of Black also under Water line  
 the bottom recoated with 1 Coat Red Lead & Zinc paint & one of Zinc  
 above that with 2 Coats Yellow over these Rudder & Steering  
 gear overhauled
