 tree rails at the fore end both sides. - increased the length
 of the after hatchway. decreased the length of the Main.

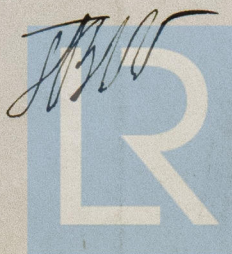

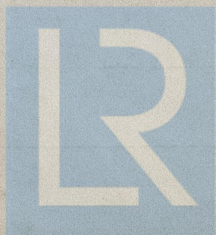
