REPAIRS, &c.

Scraped the bottom, overhauled and made good the Caulking of the busses. Lifted the man hole doors, and shake of Ceiling at the turn of the bilges. — Cleaned her out, and examined the Asphalt, found it good and adhering satisfactorily. — Overhauled ribs, ribs, and plating inside and outside as far as practicable. Rebuilt the Pikes to ladder. — Repaired the lining or ceiling on the top of false bottom, and at the bilges. — Recoated and painted or pay'd with red lead and other composition. — 'Busside and inside'

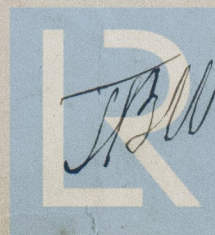
