This Vessel caught fire under the following circumstances viz. The Funnel to Donkey Engine being overheated, it set fire to some road work near at hand, in consequence of which the under side of Deck became slightly charred, this has been rectified by "pads" and lining &c; the Funnel in question is now encased with Cement and Iron, leaving a clear space around of about 14 ins, and is in my opinion now free from all danger.
