REPAIRS, &c. None done through damage -

Starboard side - Fire plates in the flat of bottom, one plate in the sheers trake forward - & the bulwark plate in way of same taken out straightened & refitted; six floors amidships were slightly fractured at their upper edge - & to compensate for such double straps are fitted over same, one frame part renewed & ten butt straps of the garboard strake riveted -

Port side - The fore foot-plate taken out - straightened & refitted, & nine butt straps of the garboard strake riveted -

The bottom chipped & caulked in places, & also scraped & painted.
