The spaces between the fore-awning deck Amidships & the monkey fore-castle & raised quarter deck have now been covered in forming a continuous deck for that length, but the vessel's tonnage is not affected by it. The beams are of single angle iron 5x3x9/16 spaced about 3 1/2' 6" apart, plating 9/16" & deck of 3" J Pine. The hull scraped & painted where required.
